Definitions of Child: for the purpose of this policy is defined as anyone under the age of eighteen years in accordance with Article 1 of the UN Convention on Rights of the Child

Definitions of A Vulnerable Adult for the purpose of this policy refers to an adult who may be unable to protect themselves from harm or exploitation

The purpose of this policy statement is:

- To protect both children, young people and adults using the Moira Replan Centre
- To protect staff, volunteers, and trustees connected with Moira Replan Centre
- To provide a safe, secure environment for all groups within the centre
- Building a safeguarding culture where everyone regardless of age, gender, gender identity or expression, sexual orientation, race, religion or belief, economic background, health issues mental ill health and physical disabilities, treat each other with respect, without fear of harassment and are comfortable about sharing any concerns
- To ensure all regardless of age
- Adopting safeguarding best practice through our policies, procedures, and code of conduct for staff and volunteers
- Ensure the safety and wellbeing of children and adults using the internet or mobile devices within Moira Replan Centre
- To ensure that risk assessment procedures are in place and regularly reviewed
- To ensure the person responsible for safeguarding is known to those using Moira Replan
